Scar: Type I minocycline induced hyperpigmentation (discoloration in sites of prior inflammation or <u>scars</u>)

Shin: Type II minocycline induced hyperpigmentation (discoloration on the shins)

## I have Scars on my Shin from the Sun

**Sun:** Type III minocycline induced hyperpigmentation (discoloration in <u>sun</u>-exposed areas)

This mnemonic describes 3 types of minocycline induced hyperpigmentation:

Type I: Blue black pigmentation in sites of prior inflammation or scars (iron-containing pigment granules.

Type II: Blue-gray ecchymotic macules and patches, most commonly on the shins (iron or melanin containing pigment granules)

Type III: Diffuse brown pigmentation on sun-exposed areas (increased melanin in the basal layer or dermal melanophages)
